




Total Employment


Sources of Job Growth






Real GDP Growth


Hachman Industrial Diversity Index by State, 2016


Private Equity Investment by State, 2012 to 2017





West Virginia Per Capita Personal Income Relative to US




Share of Personal Income by Component












Labor Force Participation by State, 2018



Labor Force Participation West Virginia and the United States




Labor Force Participation for People 25-54 Years Old West Virginia and the United States






Population and Migration Trends

West Virginia Population by Age Group, 1900-2017




Births – Deaths by Region






Population Change by Components



Age Distribution: Out-Migrants vs Population






Educational Attainment

People with a Bachelor's Degree or Higher West Virginia and the United States




People with a Bachelor's Degree or Higher by Region



High-School Age Population, West Virginia and the United States




College Going Rate, West Virginia and United States




Drug Related Deaths, West Virginia and the United States




Drugs-Related Death by Region, 2010-2017 Average




Mortality by Region, 2017
